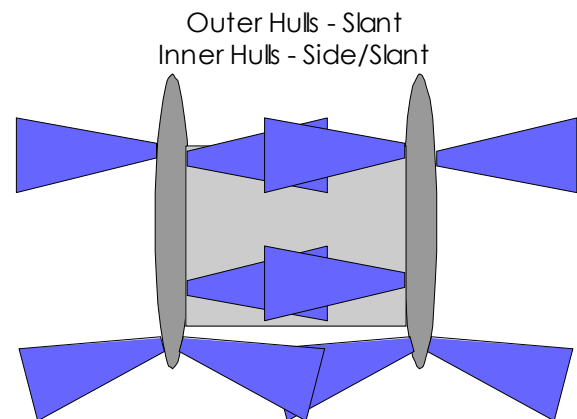
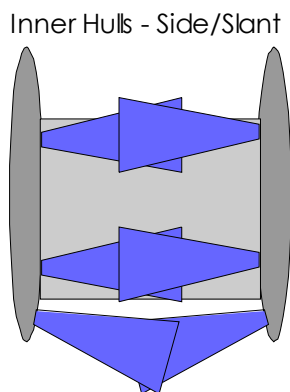
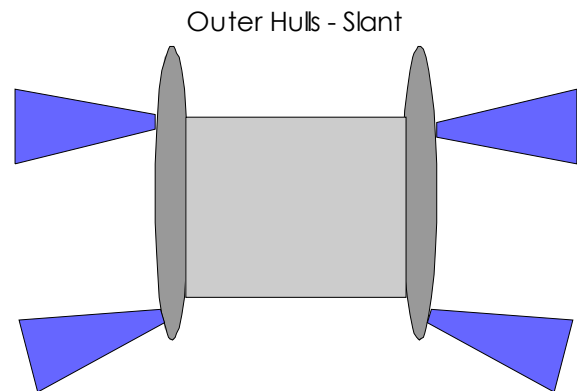
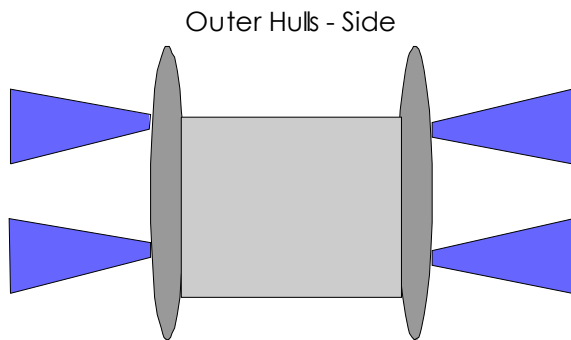


Aqualuma Underwater Lights - Multihulls

Though the majority of Aqualuma Underwater Light installations are on mono-hulls and power cruisers, by definition the configuration of multihulls offers many more options when it comes to selecting preferred light locations.

The most popular location for the installation of Aqualumas is the stem of the vessel with the Aqualumas beaming rearward, however on some multihulls such as sailing catamarans with tapered 'wine glass' stems this is simply not possible.

This by no means reduces the appeal of installing Aqualumas on multihulls because the fact that there are four hull sides (ie port and starboard sides x 2 hulls) creates even more opportunities to achieve a stunning underwater light effect. Below are several options to consider when planning an Aqualuma installation on tapered multihulls.



When it comes to Aqualuma Underwater Light installations, the possibilities are limited only by the imagination of the owner, and of course the physical characteristics of the vessel.
