

Stage 3A Water Restrictions

Melbourne is in the grip of one of the most serious droughts on record, and as a result Stage 3A water restrictions are in place and have impacted on methods available to clean boats.

Note: Previous signage affixed to row gates purporting to originate from South East Water entitled "Extracts Relevant To Boats" is incorrect and only applies to trailerable boats which can be transported to a commercial vehicle cleaning facility.

It is NOT accurate with regard to large non-transportable boats.

South East Water has confirmed the following:

- **Cleaning corrosive or hazardous substances from a vehicle (vessel) as only required is not restricted when the vessel is too large to be transported to a commercial vehicle cleaning facility.**
- **Buckets and sponges must be used when and if possible.**
- **Hoses cannot be used under any circumstances unless attached to a high pressure water unit. (Karcher, Gurney, etc)**
- **Only large boats that can not be taken to a commercial car wash may be cleaned at the marina.**

Penalties apply for non-compliance.

Please exercise restraint in the use of water, and use water as wisely and efficiently as possible here at the marina and everywhere else as well.
